Budget for 2023:

• £157,361 (up from £140,360 in 2022) based on 950 members (including 250 new members).

Questionnaires:

Questionnaires were sent out to members and SCDs at the start of 2023 to assess the current situation and challenges we face.

Challenges: -

- Reengaging face to face events.
- Reduced attendances especially with online events.
- Maximising budgets as some was returned back to HQ at end of 2022.
- Introducing new members.
- No new UK & Ireland bank account at present. SCD's need to pay and claim back for each event which is a cause of frustration.
- Increased paperwork and claims.

Plans for 2023: -

All SCD's (except 2) have been in contact with SC Coordinator to discuss challenges, and plans for 2023 and beyond. Very worthwhile exercise.

• Regional Roadshows

- o 6 regional events across the section
- Joint SC events with combination of ITI education, social activity and introduction of potential new members
- Hybrid funding and support with Straumann.
- Plan Well advertised, well organised, and well supported.

• Events

- SC's with 4 events have been requested to host 2 before 31st July. If completed, then 2 more events can be scheduled, or the unused event budgets will be reallocated.
- Hybrid events to be encouraged to engage areas where geography is challenging.
- Increased support from Straumann TM's

Paperwork

- o More support for SCD's with paperwork and supporting documents.
- SCD's What App group has been set up to help share details of events and share ideas.
