A Brave New World for Implant Dentistry

Course Description

Implant dentistry has changed considerably since Dr. Branemark published his discovery of osseointegration. The modern implant materials and design have made it possible to achieve predictable survival rates, but unfortunately, sometimes, the prosthetic results are far from ideal. The evolution of imaging technology and computer-assisted surgery associated with a restorative-driven treatment plan can provide successful outcomes for our patients. Until recently, computers have only been at the periphery of health science, used primarily for research and record keeping. Today, combining computer science and medicine leads to various breakthroughs. This presentation will discuss aspects of treatment planning and technologies that can catalyze better long-term success for the implant patient. We will cover Cone Bean Tomography treatment planning, CAD/CAM surgical guides, and computer-aided surgery.

Dr. Gonzaga is a reviewer for multiple peer-reviewed journals such as the Journal of Prosthodontics, JPD, IJOMI, and IJPRD. He practices at the Center for Implant Dentistry focusing on treating complex cases involving surgical or prosthetic needs with dental implants.
