

Dr Su Sheng Quach completed a Bachelor of Pharmacy at The University of Sydney in 2012 and subsequently went on to complete a Doctor of Dental Medicine (The University of Sydney) in 2016. Between 2017 and 2020, Sheng worked as a general dentist both at The Tweed Hospital in NSW and privately in Brisbane, before pursuing specialist periodontics training at The University of Queensland, which he completed in 2023. Sheng was awarded a Certificate in Periodontology by the European Federation of Periodontology, meeting international standards and requirements in terms of clinical performance and scientific proficiency. Sheng's thesis examined, in a clinical study, the regeneration of periodontal defects associated with impacted third molars, for which he was awarded the Greg Seymour research medallion and ANZAP Research Medallion.

Sheng is a director for the Brisbane International Team for Implantology (ITI) Study Club. Recently, Sheng was a finalist, competing in France, in an international open competition seeking to identify new leaders in implantology education (Mega Mind 2024).

As well as working at Brisbane City Periodontics & Implants (BCPI), Sheng currently works as an associate lecturer and clinical supervisor in Periodontology at The University of Queensland, teaching undergraduate and postgraduate level periodontics. Sheng has a special interest in managing implant disease and is currently undertaking research investigating more accurate and predictable ways to diagnose and treat such conditions.
