The Proceedings of the 6th ITI Consensus Conference are now available.

Basel, Switzerland, October 23, 2018 – The findings of the 6th ITI Consensus Conference held in Amsterdam in April 2018 are now available. Published as a free open-access online supplement to *Clinical Oral Implants Research*, the Proceedings can be accessed and downloaded from the Wiley Online Library as well as the ITI website.

At its 6th ITI Consensus Conference, the ITI gathered together more than 150 professionals from all over the world to review the latest literature. In preparation for the 3-day conference, 21 systematic reviews in five categories were prepared by 80 authors and co-authors. The main topics covered were surgery, prosthodontics, patient-reported outcomes, complications/risk and digital technologies. The discussions and deliberations of the five working groups culminated in consensus statements, clinical recommendations and recommendations for future research that can now be consulted online.

“Evidence-based science is central to the ITI philosophy and our regular ITI Consensus Conferences ensure that the implant dentistry community is kept informed of the latest findings at its disposal in regard to treatment approaches,” commented ITI President Stephen Chen. “The Proceedings of the 6th ITI Consensus Conference, published as an open-access supplement in order to reach as broad an audience as possible, will serve to guide implant dentistry practitioners for the five years ahead.”
